A Special Meeting of the Town Board was held on Thursday, October 27<sup>th</sup>, 2009 at 7:20 PM with the following members present: Richard Rowland, Supervisor; Daniel Pemrick, Peter Coseo and Daniel Cochran, Councilman. Thomas Kinsella was absent. Also present was Highway Supt. Walter Barss.

RESOLUTION # 140 – Preliminary Budget Adoption and Calling  
Public Hearing Thereon

RESOLVED, That this Town Board does hereby prepare and approve as the Preliminary Budget of this Town for the fiscal year beginning on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 2010, the itemized statements or estimated revenues and expenditures along with a copy of the Exemption Impact Report hereto attached and made a part of this Resolution, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That such preliminary Budget shall be filed in the office of the Town Clerk where it shall be available for inspection by any interested person at all reasonable hours, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Town Clerk give notice of such public hearing in the manner provided in Section 113 of the Town Law, and that such notice be published in substantially the following form: NOTICE OF HEARING UPON PRELIMINARY BUDGET

NOTICE is hereby given that the Preliminary Budget of the Town of Greenfield for the fiscal year beginning January 1st, 2010 has been completed and filed, along with a copy of the Exemption Impact Report, in the office of the Town Clerk, Town Hall, Greenfield Center, NY where it is available for inspection by any interested person at all reasonable hours.

FURTHER NOTICE is hereby given that the Town Board of the Town of Greenfield will meet and review said preliminary budget and hold a public hearing thereon, at the Town Hall, Greenfield Center, NY at 7:20 PM on the 5th day of November, 2009, and that at that hearing any person may be heard in favor of or against the preliminary budget as compiled, or for or against any item or items as therein contained.

Pursuant to Section 113 of the Town Law, the proposed salaries of the following Town officers are hereby specified as follows: Supervisor - \$18,211.; Councilman (4) each \$7,162.; Town Clerk - \$41,327.; Town Justices - \$13,898.; and Highway Superintendent - \$56,228.

Cochran, C. had to leave the meeting at this time to attend the Planning Board meeting.

Truck Lift - Highway Supt. Barss stated that in order to get the truck lift for the New Town Garage under State Contract pricing it would have to be ordered by October 31<sup>st</sup>, 2009. It will take approximately 3 to 4 months for delivery from the time it is ordered. Coseo, C. asked what the procedure would be and if it would have to go out to bid. Highway Supt. Barss noted that because it was on State Contract they would not

be required to go out to bid. Coseo, C. stated that the money to purchase the lift is included in next year's budget.

RESOLUTION # 141 – Approve Purchase of Truck Lift
